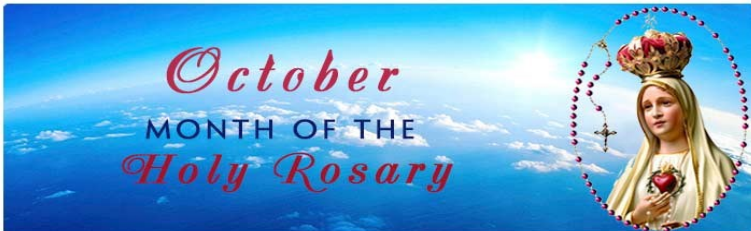

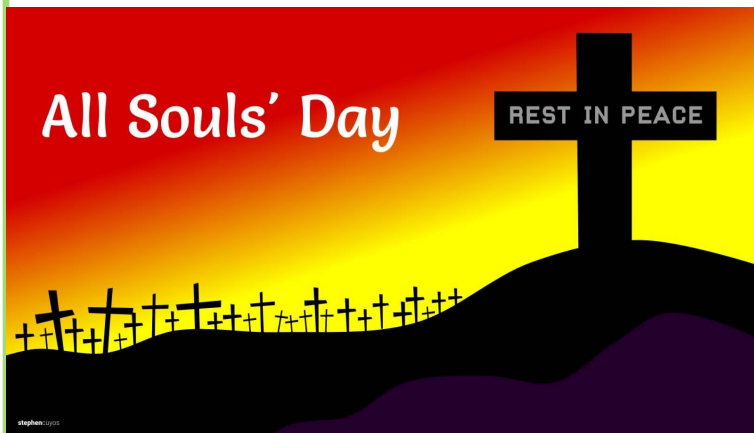
## SOLEMNITY OF ALL SAINTS

## ALL SOULS DAY MASS

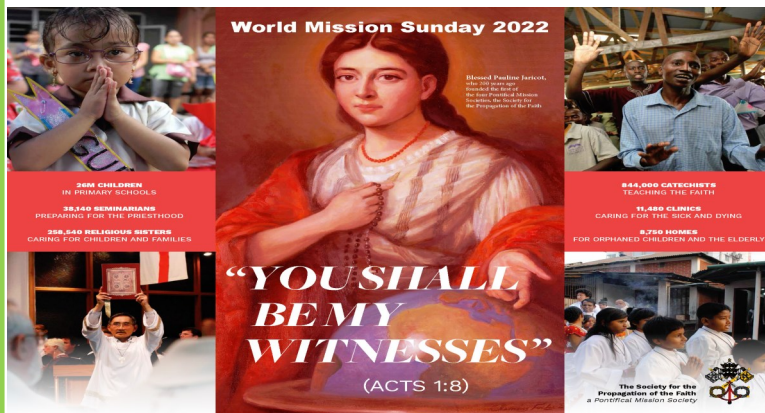
