## Memorial Mass for Miscarriage, Stillbirth, and Infant Loss

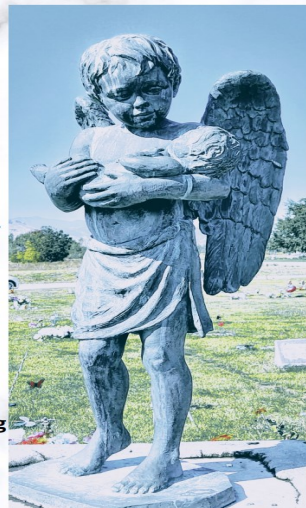

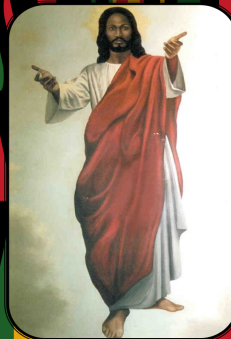
